upc cablecom "Best Swiss Corporate Network Carrier" again

In the latest published Telekom Rating from Swiss business magazine "BILANZ", upc cablecom has for the fifth time taken first place in the "Corporate Network Carrier" category. In addition, the largest cable network company in Switzerland made a giant leap to fourth place overall in the "Fixed Telephony" category. The rating is conducted annually and is based on a representative survey of business customers of the major Swiss telecommunications companies.

This year is already the twelfth time that the BILANZ Telekom Rating has been carried out, with more than 1,000 business customers once again passing judgement on their telecommunications partners. Consequently, the rating is seen as a sound indicator of customer satisfaction.

upc cablecom has succeeded in taking first place in the "Corporate Network" category for the fifth time in the last seven years. Marco Quinter, Managing Director of Business Services, explains the reasons for this top result as follows: "Our ongoing optimisation efforts in the central areas of infrastructure, security, services and staff have paid off. As a result, we are now in a position to offer our various customers – from SMEs through to multinational companies – customised solutions with an optimal price-performance ratio".

upc cablecom also took a giant leap forwards in the "Fixed Network Telephony" category, succeeding in climbing from ninth place the previous year to fourth place in the current rating. In the Internet Services category, the cable network operator was placed seventh as in the previous year.

Top in virtually all areas

A total of five different criteria were assessed in the BILANZ survey: quality, innovation, price, flexibility and support. With five being the top score, upc cablecom succeeded in obtaining an average rating of well over four points in all categories in which it was assessed. Compared to the previous year's rating, the cable network operator succeeded in improving significantly with regard to the "Support" and "Quality" assessment criteria, recording some large



increases in all three rating categories. The company even achieved the best rating of all providers with regard to the "Innovation" and "Price" assessment criteria in the "Corporate Network Carrier" category.

Investments pay off

For Eric Tveter, Managing Director of upc cablecom, the current rating is the logical consequence of the multiple measures implemented to improve the customer experience: "This result is due to our huge investments in the network and in our services. We are now already in a position to be able to offer our business and private customers Internet speeds and support services which other providers throughout Switzerland will not be able to offer for some years to come, and only after making huge investments."
